

The Notice of Privacy Practices of MMM Healthcare, LLC. (MMM) has been recently updated.

The following summary of changes were made:

Other reasons we may use or share your information:

<u>Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Information.</u>

We may receive SUD information from Providers or programs regulated by federal law (42 CFR Part 2). All disclosures of SUD information must comply with all applicable Federal and State privacy laws. We are allowed to Use and Disclose SUD information for certain Treatment, Payment, and Health Care Operations activities. You have the right to consent to Disclosure of SUD information in certain circumstances. You can revoke this consent in writing at any time.

Reproductive Health Care Information.

We are not allowed under federal law to disclose Reproductive Health Care (RHC) PHI in certain circumstances. RCH PHI includes, but is not limited to, information related to the reproductive health of an individual such as information pertaining to birth control, pregnancy termination, or other matters related to the reproductive health system. To the extent that section 45 CFR 164.520 remains enforceable, we cannot Use or Disclose RCH PHI when the information would be used to impose a criminal or civil penalty or identify or investigate a person for obtaining, providing, or facilitating RCH when the services were lawful under the circumstances it was provided and for certain other disclosures an attestation of compliance may be required.
